Ozona High School:

Renewing School Spirit

The Crockett County School District asked the MooreCo space planning team for assistance in redesigning the entire Ozona High School. With a modern eye for interactive design and organized classrooms, Kim Diaz and Molly Cox decided the best course of action was to ensure every piece of furniture aligned with school spirit, to increase community engagement and create a colorful layout that inspires students. Boasting a STEM room, art rooms, business centers, a journalism classroom, food science labs, and so much more, the CCSD required colorful classroom layouts that explored the idea of gathering for a common cause and, most importantly, learning by doing.

By far the most impressive layout in the CCSD is the media and dining commons, where arched floor-to-ceiling windows reminiscent of cathedrals allow bright natural lighting to fill the space. This biophilic design made it easy for the MooreCo planning team to designate seating layouts that are welcoming and energizing. [Modular soft seating](#) with added mobility package and [Elevate benches](#) were brought in to create a lounge area around ottomans where students

can gather to discuss ideas and engage in problem solving. The media area includes [Cocoon Community Tables](#) where students can gather on [Mobile Soft Seating Stools](#) for group projects and expanded workspace. The elevated dining area was outfitted with [Elevate soft seating](#) and love seats to maintain a cozy aesthetic, while [Seed Cantilever Stools](#) line the balcony railings to give students who want it a great view of the media commons below.

One of the most modern spaces the MooreCo planning team undertook was the robotics and esports center, where competitive gaming and experiential learning takes place. [Compass Makerspace Tables](#) are the highlight of this room, paired with stools that can be easily converted to standing desk capacity and storage space, with [Ogee Curved Easels](#) to keep all necessary tools nearby. [Soft lounge seating](#) is placed strategically in front of a widescreen TV, where gamers can remain comfortable and seated near other members of their community.

Classrooms were all designed uniquely, but a common theme is the [Hierarchy Fender by MooreCo Desk](#), which roughly takes the shape of a guitar to

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inspire creativity. Each desk can be fitted into one another to create larger surface areas for group projects and collaboration.

Floral design and art rooms follow the STEM rooms with [Compass Makerspace Tables](#) to inspire creative endeavors. The computer lab gives purpose to [Hierarchy 5-Star Chairs](#), which give mobility while students are seated at computers. The yearbook and journalism classroom is a more active space, where students are walking around and expending energy,

so we lined this room with the [Hierarchy Grow Stool®](#) and standing curved easels for brainstorming ideas. We also elevated hallways, corridors, cool down areas, reception, teacher workrooms, and conference rooms with soft seating, ottomans, [Hierarchy chairs and stools](#), and other professional touches to align the entire design. ■
